Schooley Mitchell of Louisa (Lee and Marla Balaklaw), have been our telecom consultants for the past 10 years. Over that time, they have saved us tens of thousands of dollars. They have saved us a great deal of time dealing with telephone (analog and sip trunks), internet (fiber and coax), and cellular accounts.

Schooley Mitchell has consulted with our IT provider, CDP. They have spent time dealing with the Commonwealth Office of Technology on our behalf.
